READING FOR THE FUTURE: A MULTI-FACTOR APPROACH

The Achieve Brown County Collective Impact Partnership launched three action teams to address the root causes of early-grade reading challenges. Building on learnings from the first action teams we convened from 2017–2020 and using guidance from the national StriveTogether Network, we are laying the groundwork for sustainable change.

HISTORIC FIRST: ALL-TEAMS CONVENING

We brought together all of our action teams. This is the first time in our history that we have multiple teams focused on the same BIG GOAL. This collaboration underscores the power of collective action and our shared commitment to young people throughout all of Brown County.

RALLYING OUR COMMUNITY FOR EARLY LITERACY

Reading at grade level by third grade is a critical milestone for every child's success and only 54% of Brown County's third graders are meeting this benchmark. In response to this growing early literacy crisis, we hosted three Right to Read film screenings to educate the community, bring together partners, spark important conversations, and inspired new collaborators to join our collective effort.
