USING DATA TO DRIVE CHANGE

Improving outcomes for children and youth requires more than good intentions—it requires good information. At ABC, data is a foundational pillar of our collective impact approach. We use data as a flashlight, not a hammer. It illuminates challenges, highlights opportunities, and measures progress. By making data publicly available, individuals, organizations, and ABC's collaborative action teams can make informed decisions that improve outcomes across the community. In 2025, we launched new dashboards designed to help partners and residents better understand what's working, where gaps remain, and where we should focus next.

RALLYING OUR COMMUNITY FOR EARLY LITERACY - A MULTI-FACTOR APPROACH

In 2025, our collaborative action teams identified seven priority projects focused on addressing the root causes of early-grade literacy challenges. To guide this work, we hosted community listening sessions and literacy convenings to gather insights from individuals with lived experience. These projects are laying the groundwork for meaningful, long-term change by:

- collecting essential data to track progress,
- building awareness of what a true county wide culture of literacy looks like,
- piloting new strategies to improve reading outcomes.

Throughout the year, the ABC backbone team organized and facilitated more than 55 meetings to move this work forward.
